AoD Connect

A Peer Support Service to help disabled people become independent and confident citizens. Connecting you through courses, workshops, groups and social activities.

Disability Connect Westminster

Linking deaf & disabled people living in Westminster to mainstream services and opportunity.

Adult Advocacy

Supporting people to have their voice heard and to secure their rights.

Employment Service

Supporting disabled people with learning difficulties into employment.

Youth Service

A range of holiday and term-time inclusive activities that support young disabled people towards independence.

Full service from form filling to tribunal support for disabled people and carers.
